Risk of iron-deficiency anemia and undernourishment in residents of Belen, Iquitos, Peru

Purpose of Study: Assess anemia prevalence and undernourishment risk.

US-based Internal Review Board: University of Nevada School of Medicine

Peru-based Review Boards: Office of the Mayor of Loreto, Peru & Peruvian Ministry of Health

Source of Funding: University of Nevada School of Medicine

Budget: \$14,000 USD

Researchers: Seven University of Nevada School of Medicine rising second year medical students in the field, site Principal Investigator in Peru, Peruvian support staff, and Nevada-based Principal Investigator.

Hypertension Prevalence in Rural Orangers, Haiti

Purpose of Study: Provide baseline assessment of hypertension and evidence of causes.

Source of Funding: Online Fundraising

Budget: \$2,000 USD

Researchers: One master's student, two local Haitian doctors and one community health mentor.

Purpose of Study: Assess parasitosis burden in pediatric populations
